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Teacher Notes

Hi2/2.1 Local History

Pupils should be taught about an aspect of local history

For example: a study over time tracing how several aspects of national history are reflected in the locality (this can go beyond 1066)

Hi2/2.1 Extended chronological study

Pupils should be taught a study of an aspect or theme in British history that extends pupils' chronological knowledge beyond 1066

For example: (b) changes in an aspect of social history, such as leisure and entertainment in the 20th Century

Resource materials:

Text and information is arranged in 8 sections with activities for students to choose from.

Topics can be studied in isolation, although the materials follow on from one another, tracing the development of Clevedon over the centuries and the importance of the Severn Estuary and Bristol Channel as a waterway for trade and leisure activities.

Some of the topics may be studied in line with the requirements of the National Curriculum or during an Awareness Day or Month.

Glossary:

Encourage students to compile their own glossary to help them understand the meaning of unfamiliar words.

To help with understanding, new vocabulary can be placed on cards and matched with definitions in a pairing exercise.

To reinforce knowledge and understanding, students can try to explain a word from their glossary to a partner.

Drawing a picture alongside the word, or using the word in a sentence can aid understanding of new word.
